

Charitable Distribution from an Individual Retirement Account

IRA Qualified Charitable Distributions, also referred to as Charitable IRA Rollovers or IRA QCDs, are a way to support the Sierra Club Foundation as a qualifying charity without incurring federal income tax liability. If you are 70 $\frac{1}{2}$ or older, you can give up to \$100,000 in tax-free charitable distributions annually from your IRA directly to the Sierra Club Foundation, and if you are age 72 or older, it can help you to meet your minimum distribution requirement.

It is my intention to make a direct charitable distribution from my Individual Retirement Account to the Sierra Club Foundation, a qualifying 501(c)(3) public charity.
